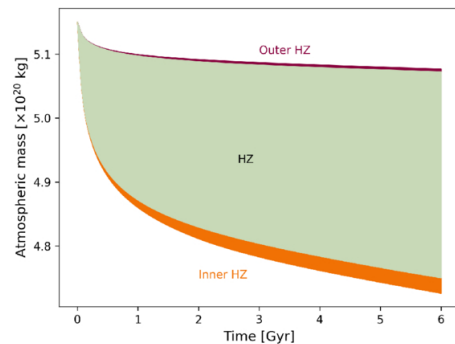


Figure 5. from

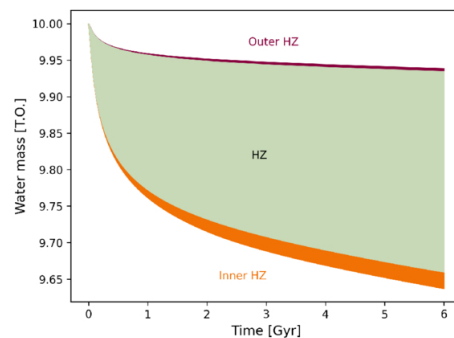

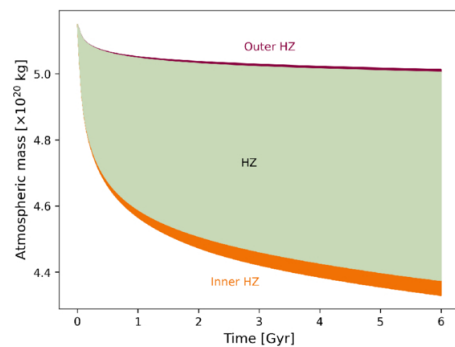
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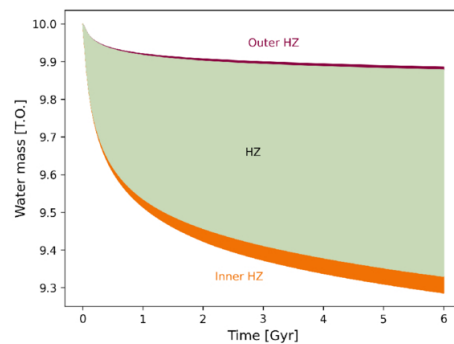
(a) Atmospheric evolution of Earth orbiting a G-dwarf (Sun).



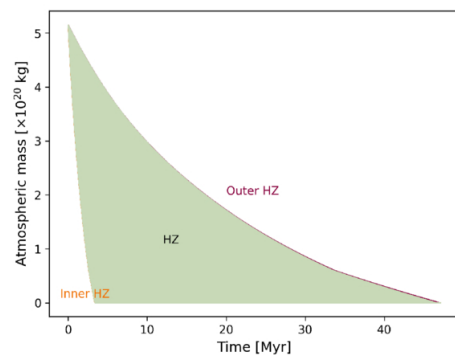
(b) Water loss evolution of Earth orbiting a G-dwarf (Sun) in Terrestrial Ocean (T.O.) units.



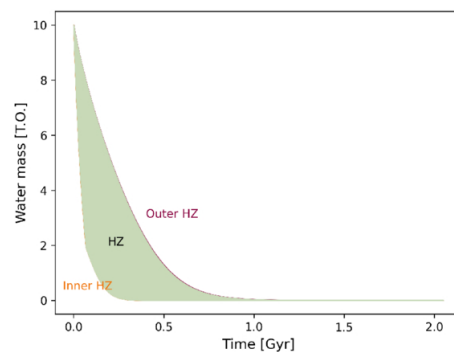
(c) Atmospheric evolution of Earth orbiting a K-dwarf (HD22049).
