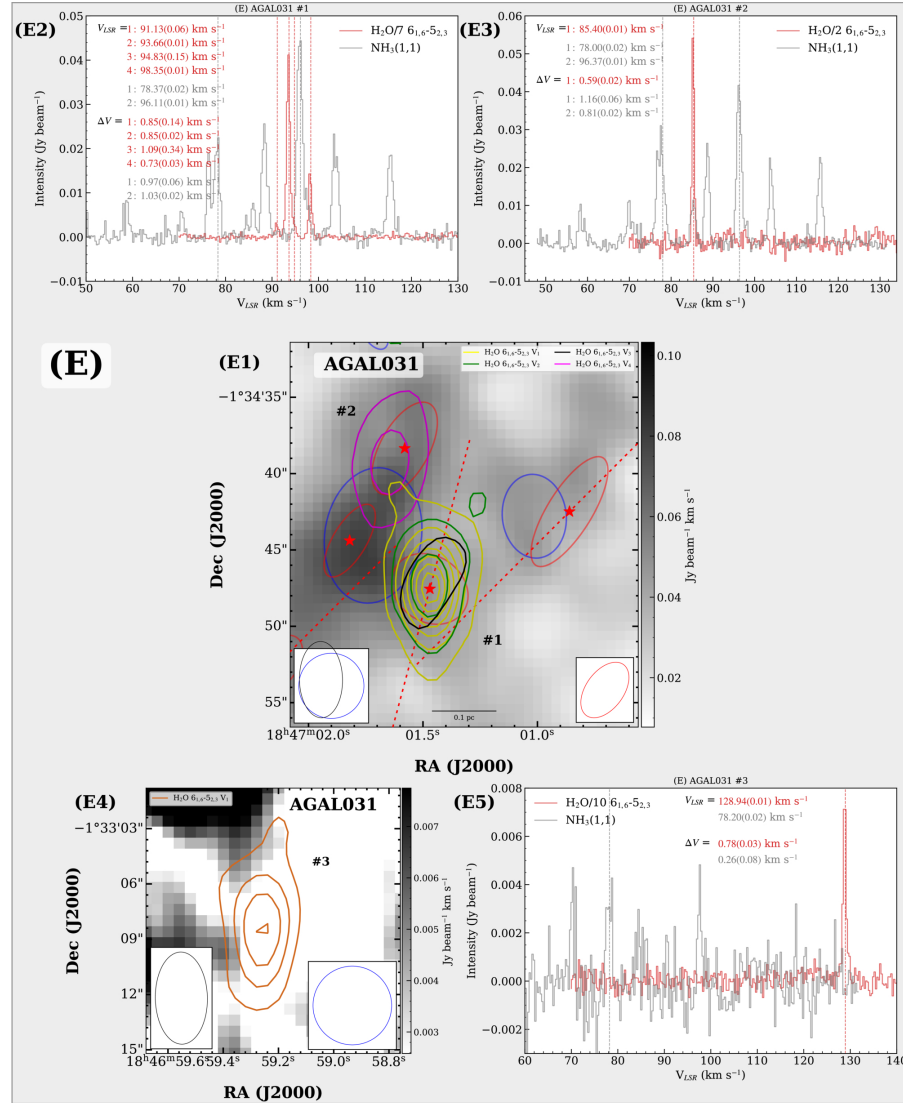


Figure 1. from

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(E) For Reg. #1, the adopted intervals are 90.3–92.1, 92.1–96.3, and 96.3–100.2 km s⁻¹. Four velocity components are present, with the V_2 and V_3 components integrated together. The intervals are 83.7–87.0 km s⁻¹ for Reg. #2 and 126.6–130.8 km s⁻¹ for Reg. #3. The magenta, black, green, and yellow H_2O contours start at 20.6, 15.2, 22.4, and 23.3 mJy beam⁻¹ km s⁻¹, with intervals of 62.2, 22.9, 67.4, and 69.9 mJy beam⁻¹ km s⁻¹, respectively.
